Historical Note: Elizabeth Frances Corbett was a noted Milwaukee author. One of three children, Elizabeth Corbett grew up on the grounds of a Civil War veterans' home near Milwaukee where her father, Major Richard W. Corbett, was a member of the staff. She graduated from West Division High School in Milwaukee. She received her B.A., Phi Beta Kappa, from the University of Wisconsin in 1910. After her father's death in 1927, she and her mother moved to New York City. During her lifetime Corbett authored more than 50 novels, and wrote short stories, plays, and many articles. Her stories often include reflections on what life was like in old Milwaukee.
