Abstract: Governor Gaylord Nelson formally organized the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission on August 8, 1960. It has served as the official area-wide planning agency for southeastern Wisconsin, encompassing Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha. Its purpose was to provide information and professional planning initiatives to help solve and focus attention on issues of regional importance, such as highways, water supply, sewerage, parks, air/water pollution, land use and transit.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of annual reports, newsletters, publications and technical reports.
