Eligibility and Standards

All artists who create quality arts and crafts of original concept and execution are welcome. We are seeking variety, and encourage artists working with and creating non-traditional artwork to apply. Use of commercial kits, prefabricated forms, molds, purchased products, or direct sale items are prohibited. Artists may not share booth space except where there is collaboration in the work. The committee reserves the right to refuse an artist whose work does not represent the pictures submitted for jurying or who fails to comply with State or Village requirements.

Jurying Policy

All applicants must enclose four current pictures, three of work and one of booth setup, to be evaluated for craftsmanship, originality, and design. These pictures will be the only criteria used in selection. It is important that they be clear and in focus. Photographs will be used to verify design quality at the show, so it is important that they accurately represent your work. All pictures will be returned to applicants.

Application Procedure

Complete a Wisconsin Sellers Permit form as well as the Attached Form. The Milwaukee County Historical Society must forward the Sellers Permit form to the State of Wisconsin for all exhibitors. Birth date is required per Village of Greendale statute.

1. Enclose:

- Please send three (3) photos of your work and (1) of your booth setup. Emailed photos are accepted.
- Completed application and Wisconsin Sellers Permit form.
- For registration by March 6th, early registration fees are \$140 for Outdoor Booth, \$160 for Indoor Booth, or \$85 for a half booth in the Stone Barn.
- For registration received after March 6th, regular fees are \$160 for Outdoor Booth, \$180 for Indoor Booth Fee or \$100 for a half booth in the Stone Barn.
- \$20 trailer or additional car fee (pass required), if applicable.

3. Application deadline is August 1, 2015.

Additional Information

- Booth space is 10' x 10' (approximately).
- All checks are held until March 31, 2015.
- Notification of acceptance or rejection will be mailed or emailed in April.
- Exhibitors receive all proceeds from sales and are responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax.
- Setup: Friday from 12 pm - 7 pm (encouraged); Sat. and Sun. from 7 am - 9:30 am. Camping is not allowed on the grounds.
- Raffle: Artists are asked to donate an item (tax-deductible) for the raffle. A receipt will be provided. This year, the exhibitor's item with the most tickets Sunday, at start of raffle drawing will receive a FREE registration fee to the 2016 Harvest Festival (\$140 value!).
- Exhibitors will receive space allocation, directions, and parking passes in August.
- One vehicle per space is permitted and must be parked in designated lots. Additional vehicles and trailers require a \$20 permit.
- We try to accommodate space requests but cannot guarantee them.
- All fees are non-refundable once accepted into the show.

The Milwaukee County Historical Society will not assume any liability in the case of loss or damage to work from any cause. Insurance responsibility is left to the artist. Artists will abide by Village of Greendale ordinances and Wisconsin state law including compliance with Fire Department and Village building regulations, and will indemnify and hold harmless the Milwaukee County Historical Society, its directors, its officers, the Village of Greendale, and the Milwaukee County Parks Department for any claim or cause of action against those mentioned from acts of exhibitors or anyone else.
