Abstract: The growing popularity of automobiles in the early 20th century, sparked calls to improve county roads and develop a system of highways. The Wisconsin legislature passed a highway law in 1911 led to the hiring of H.J. Kuelling as Milwaukee County's first highway commissioner.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of annual reports from 1915-1920. They contain financial figures on the cost of highway construction and maintenance as well as photos of various roads.
