Abstract: Leo Tiefenthaler was born in Milwaukee in July 1880. He taught school in the city for several years before enrolling at the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1907 to earn bachelor's and master's degrees in political science. He served as Milwaukee's municipal reference librarian from 1911 until 1917, when he left to become civic secretary for the City Club of Milwaukee. The club was formed in 1909 to promote effective local government and civic progress. He died in November 1974.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of notes from his classes at UW-Madison, a Washington Irving Society journal & constitution, a Henry C. Campbell memorial book, newspaper clippings, theater-related playbills and programs, and a scrapbook of family clippings and notes.
