Abstract: Square D originally was the Detroit Fuse and Manufacturing Company, which was established in 1902. It manufactured electrical distribution and industrial control equipment. In 1917, the company changed its name to Square D. It merged with Industrial Controller of Milwaukee in 1929 with its offices and manufacturing plant at 710 S. 3rd Street and became a leader in the production of automatic electric controls for industrial use. In 1941, the company moved to a new facility on N. Richards Street. The company was acquired by Schneider Electric in 1991.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of annual reports, product manuals, advertisements, bulletins and a 50th anniversary history.
