**Abstract:** Eugene Luening and Hans Bruening founded the Wisconsin College of Music in 1899, and Bruening served as director until his death in March 1922. In 1968 the college merged with the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music and set up shop in the College's building at 1584 N. Prospect Avenue (the school's current site). For a short period, the school was called the Wisconsin-College-Conservatory of Music, but in 1971 the name was changed to the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of catalogues, commencement programs and recital programs.
