Abstract: The Milwaukee Project was part of the Suburban Resettlement Division of the New Deal's Resettlement Administration. The project involved the acquisition of land that was used to create the Greenbelt community of Greendale.

Scope and Content: The collection contains appraisals, land acquisition materials, and maps (primarily of the Town of Greenfield and community of Greendale). The appraisals extensively cover rural areas that became Greendale and include information on the nature of farms and dwellings there. There also is material specific to project employee Max Sievers.
