Abstract: Peace Action-Wisconsin is a peace and justice organization working to abolish the threats of war and nuclear weapons and promoting non-violence as a way of life to meet human needs and preserve the environment. The organization was founded as Milwaukee Mobilization for Survival in March 1977, part of a national network of national peace and justice groups organized around the issues of nuclear weapons, nuclear power, the escalating arms race and the decline in funding for human needs. National Mobilization for Survival grew to include over 125 peace and justice groups before its national office closed in 1992.

In January 1996 we affiliated with National Peace Action, which had been formed from the merger of SANE and the Nuclear Freeze Campaign. It is the largest grassroots peace and disarmament group in the country. In 1999 we became Peace Action-Wisconsin to reflect our statewide scope and membership.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of directories, newsletters and other ephemera detailing the organization's work at the local, state, regional and national levels.
