

**Title:** Pastorino, Frank Collection

**Abstract:** Frank Pastorino (1864-1910) was born in Narone (near Genoa), Sardinia, and immigrated to the United States with his parents in 1865. In 1891 he moved from Chicago to Milwaukee where he bought a commission firm. In 1895 the firm, Pastorini & Schiappacasse, wholesale dealers in fruits and nuts, moved from 134 W. Water Street to the new Commission Row Building which occupied the entire block between Buffalo and Detroit streets.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of photocopied historic documents, photographs and two pieces of contemporary correspondence involving Elizabeth Turecek, the great-granddaughter of Frank Pastorino. For photos, see the Frank Pastorino Family, M-43. Many of the photos are the same as the photocopies in the manuscript collection.
