Abstract: Ernst Schuffenhauer was born on October 12, 1843 in Meldenau, Germany. He immigrated to the U.S. in 1873 with his wife and two sons, seeking religious freedom. They settled in Milwaukee, where Ernst worked for many years as a mason. He joined the Frei Gemeinde Society, was a founding member of the local branch of the International Bricklayers' Union in 1885, and joined the Socialist Party in 1886. He passed away in March 1931.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of genealogical material, Schuffenhauer's certificate of naturalization, funeral book, probate records, birth certificate, Confirmation certificate and property-related documents.
