**Abstract:** In 1919, a group of Milwaukeeans formed a Lawn Bowling Club and played games at Stickney Field in Wauwatosa. The following year, the Milwaukee Lawn Bowling Association was organized, and new greens were built in Lake Park. A group of bowlers formed the Sherman Park Lawn Bowling Club and played on a green in Sherman Park. The Sherman Park green closed in 1967 when new greens opened in Dineen Park.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of brochures, flyers, score cards, a history and chronology of various organizations, pamphlets, rules, rosters, newspaper clippings and photocopies of photos. These records pertain to the Milwaukee Lawn Bowling Association but also other clubs, such as the Milwaukee Lawn Bowls Club and the Sherman Park Lawn Bowling Association.
