Abstract: Henry M. Benjamin was born in Plerchen, Prussia, on July 30, 1841. He immigrated to the U.S. when he was 15 years old and worked in the grocery/dry goods trades in several locations before relocating to Milwaukee in 1868. He and a partner purchased a wood and coal yard, and it became a thriving business. He was an important figure in Milwaukee's Jewish community and in the city at large, serving as an alderman and acting mayor during the 1870s. He passed away in 1918.
