**Abstract:** Richard Teschner was a lawyer/partner in the Quarles & Brady law firm. In 1960, he became chairman of the Milwaukee County War Memorial Development Committee and helped spearhead Milwaukee's drive to establish a performing arts center. When the Performing Arts Center was completed in 1969, Teschner served on the PAC's Board of Directors.

**Scope and Content:** The records consist of correspondence, clippings, minutes, programs, reports, brochures and photos that detail Teschner's involvement with the Performing Arts Center.
