**Historical Note:** Harold Story worked for Allis-Chalmers from 1919 to 1957 as General Attorney and Vice-President. He was born on June 4, 1890, attended West Division High School and obtained his law degree from the University of Wisconsin in 1915. He began his law practice with Quarles, Spence & Quartles but joined the military with the outbreak of World War I. After the war, he practiced law with Lenicheck, Boesel, Wickham & Story until he joined Allis-Chalmers in 1919. During his years at A-C, Story became widely known for his expertise in labor issues. He was actively involved with many civic groups, and after his retirement from Allis-Chalmers, he served on the Milwaukee School Board.

**Scope and Content:** The records consist of correspondence, clippings, speeches, photos, reports, awards, and other ephemera that document Story's involvement in World War I, his activities with Allis-Chalmers and the School Board, and his love of duck hunting.
