**Historical Note:** William McCauley was born on February 24, 1900, in Escanaba, Michigan. He graduated from Marquette University’s Law School in 1923 and set up a law practice in Milwaukee. He served as the city’s Assistant District Attorney from 1933 to 1937 and District Attorney in Milwaukee from 1945 until his death on October 31, 1964. McCauley was involved in Democratic Party politics and actively campaigned on behalf of several Democratic presidential nominees. He was also a member of the electoral college from 1932 to 1940 and served as a delegate to several Democratic National Conventions.

**Scope and Content:** Records consist of correspondence, clippings, speeches, and programs relating to McCauley’s legal career and his political activities.
