Historical Note: Rose Daitsman is a social activist involved in numerous organizations devoted to changing the social fabric of Milwaukee. Her focus was assisting women and minorities burdened by poverty, while helping them advance in the fields of science and engineering. Rose has been active in cooperative housing programs in the Milwaukee area and created the Greater Milwaukee Human Rights Coalition in 2006.

Scope and Content: The majority of her collection focuses on Women's Equality, Cooperative Housing and her involvement in various social welfare groups to reform the controversial welfare program, Wisconsin Works (W-2). Also reflecting her efforts is documentation from organizations helping minorities become educated and enter careers in Science and technology. She has obtained grants to help promote women's rights and social reform. Mrs. Daitsman's campaign at running for election to the Milwaukee School Board of Directors in 1995 is also documented.
