Historical Note: Crosby was Chief of the Fire Prevention Security Department at the Pabst Brewing Company. He was a part of the 17-man crew that built the Charles Lindberg's plane the Spirit of St. Louis, and he also worked as a foreman of a machine shop at Old Mahoney-Ryan Aircraft Company. He died November 5, 1973.
