**Historical Note:** Harriet E. Dake (nee Earling) was a prominent Milwaukee social arbiter. She was born on February 12, 1879 to Margaret (Peebles) Earling and Albert J. Earling, president of the Milwaukee Road.

On June 1, 1899 Harriet married Lawrence Fitch, president of the Western Malleable Company and director of the National Exchange Bank. During the war they were active in relief work among the civilian population in France. He died in 1924. On September 15, 1927, she married Frederick Charles Thwaits, a lawyer who was prominent in the Hoover food administration. They traveled extensively and collected art. Approximately half of the correspondence in this collection is addressed to Mr. Thwaits. He died in 1944.

In 1947 she married Walter Dake, a real estate dealer. He died in 1958. Harriet passed away on October 17, 1962, at Oconomowoc Lake.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of correspondence, scrapbooks, photos and other ephemera material relating to three prominent Milwaukee families — Earling, Fitch and Thwaits.
