**Abstract:** Rudolph A. Koss was born in New Holstein, Germany, in 1823. He received medical training at the University of Heidelberg and participated in the 1848 revolutions in Germany. Government oppression prompted him and his wife, Marie, to immigrate to the United States in the early 1850s. He practiced medicine in Milwaukee for a short time before turning to literary pursuits. He wrote for the *Milwaukee Herald* and also edited the *Field and Garden News* and *Progress of Time* for a number of years. In addition, he wrote a history of Milwaukee. He passed away in 1893.
