**Administrative note:** The collection was processed on February 18, 1994 by Judith A. Simonsen. Video cassettes were added to the collection in 1995 and were processed by Steve Daily. The collection was revised on March 19, 2002. Material was added to the collection on April 27, 2000; Oct. 17-18, 2001 and was processed by Kevin Abing. In 2001 Bobby Tanzillo donated Weekly Bus Passes, MCTS. Finding aid was revised by Steve Schaffer, 2015.

**Scope and Content:** Material includes histories which span the entire era of public transportation. The earliest item is a ticket from the Milwaukee Street Railway Co. ca. 1890. The materials represent The Milwaukee Electric Railway & Light Co., Wisconsin Motor Bus Lines, Interurban operations, The Milwaukee Electric Railway & Transport Co., The Milwaukee & Suburban Transport Corp., and The Milwaukee County Transit System.
