Historical Note: William Woods Plankinton was born in Milwaukee and died in the same city in 1972 at the age of 65. His great-grandfather, John Plankinton, founded the Plankinton Packing Company and left a seven million dollar estate that became part of the Plankinton Trust Company. William worked as a free-lance photographer for the *New York Journal American* from 1936-1941. In that time he became a noted part of New York's social scene and had several photographs published on the paper's society pages. Returning to Milwaukee, he worked as chief of the State Tire Rationing Office at 110 E. Wisconsin Avenue for the Civil Defense Committee. He joined the Civil Air Patrol in 1941 and later rose to the rank of Colonel.

Plankinton's interest in travelling led him to purchase a luxury trailer from the "Flxible" Company of Loudonville, Ohio. His interest in the Civil Air Patrol, Civil Defense Committee, and the Flxible Company continued through the 1950s and 1960s. In 1958 he wed Eileen Twomey, who had worked for him as his secretary since 1938. In the decades after World War II, William lived at 3000 W. Brown Deer Road., River Hills. He died at Sacred Heart Rehabilitation Hospital of a heart ailment.
