

**Title:** Milwaukee Protestant Home for the Aged Collection

**Historical Note:** Milwaukee Protestant Home for the Aged was founded by a group of public spirited women who were interested in the needs of homeless elderly women. After meetings in old Plymouth Church attended by members of Protestant churches, officers were elected and a corporation organized in 1884. It is a non-profit, non-sectarian retirement residence for Wisconsin residents 65 years or older regardless of their financial means.
