Historical Note:

Robert Adams-Buell was one of Milwaukee's leading pianists and music instructors. He studied and performed piano both in the United States and abroad. In 1907 he joined the faculty of Lawrence College. In 1909 he went on tour with stars of the Metropolitan Opera Company. From 1911-1928 he was connected with the faculty of the Marquette University college of music as a piano teacher. In 1928 he joined the piano department of the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music, and retired in 1933 because of ill health.
