**Abstract:** Dr. Arnold E. Erling was born in Stillwater, New York, in 1869 and received his medical training at Rush Medical College, Chicago. He first practiced medicine in La Crosse, WI, and relocated to Milwaukee in 1911. He and his wife, Mertie, had four children: Gladys, William, Arnold, Jr., and James. Arnold, Jr., attended North Division High School, served in World War I, and eventually became a dentist, setting up practice in Kenosha. James served during World War II and had a life-long interest in the military. Records consist of clippings, military records, correspondence, manuals, certificates that help document the activities of the Erling family members and friend (relative?) John Heim.

**Scope and Content:** Records consist of obituaries, clippings, certificates, photos, army manuals/pamphlets, and other ephemera that help document Arnold Erling, Sr. and Jr.'s activities as well as that of other family members.
