Historical Note: Hale was born in Duluth, Minnesota on November 18, 1888. Col. Tracy J. Hale served in World War I and II with the 125th Infantry of the 32nd Division and was wounded in both wars. Hale later became a charter member of the Alonzo Cudworth American Legion Post in 1919. During his life he worked with the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Co., was a partner in the Henry C. Quarries and Company, and Milwaukee Company. He died February 20, 1956.

Scope and Content: The collection contains material relating to the military career of a Milwaukeean in World War I and II, including diaries, correspondence, photographs, and publications.
