Scope and Content:

Hazelton was born in Columbus, WI July 8 1858. Her father Gerry W. Hazelton (mother Martha) was elected to Congress in 1870. The family later moved back to Wisconsin. In Milwaukee, Anna attended the Wheelock School for Girls. Hazelton graduated from the Milwaukee-Downer College. For a significant part of her life Hazelton worked as an editorial writer for the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel, featuring literary, theatrical, and nature subjects. She also wrote for the Free Press. Hazelton died March 12, 1951. The collection is comprised of genealogy, correspondence, legal documents, and financial records.
