**Historical Note:** Frederick Layton came to Milwaukee in 1845. He and his father, John Layton, started the J&F Meat Market. In 1852 Frederick Layton and John Plankinton formed the Layton & Plankinton Packing Co. Layton withdrew in 1863 and organized the Layton Company, with himself, his father, and George Dickens as partners.

**Scope and Content:** The collection includes personal papers of Frederick Layton and business material relating to the Layton Company.

**Administrative Note:** The collection was processed on December 18, 1990 by Janet Geronime. The finding aid was retyped on October 24, 2011 by Jenny Stevenson.
