Abstract: Women of the Episcopal Church founded St. John's Home in 1868 to offer shelter for the church's deserving needy and it has evolved into one of Milwaukee's premier senior retirement centers. The initial St. John's was a small house on Sycamore Street (now W. Michigan), but high demand prompted moves to larger accommodations on Van Buren and then Cass streets. In 1979, St. John's relocated to its current facility at 1840 N. Prospect Avenue.

Scope and Content: Collection contains annual reports, auxiliary minutes, invitations, historical information, brochures and scrapbooks. Also included is a patient book from the Home and miscellaneous clippings, newsletters and photographs.
