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POSITION:

EXHIBITS AND COLLECTIONS VOLUNTEER (Project- Based)

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Projects can involve exhibit work maintenance, collections management, and updating and maintaining records.

Example Opportunities:

- Set-up and take-down of annual exhibit (runs January-April)
- Use PastPerfect to update collections records
- Exhibit Interpreter at the Historical Center

REQUIREMENTS:

Volunteers must be able to communicate effectively, be dependable, and have the ability to work independently and within a team setting. Volunteers must be 18 years or older or accompanied by an adult. Individuals interested in history are encouraged to apply. Ability to lift at least 20lbs. preferred.

TIME COMMITMENT:

There may be a minimum time commitment to remain active, based on your assigned project.

TRAINING:

Minimal training may be required based on nature of your assigned project.

BENEFITS:

- Free family admission to the Milwaukee County Historical Society's Historic Sites.
- Discount of 40% on membership in the Milwaukee County Historical Society.
- Opportunities to participate in Museum programs, events, and activities.

A criminal background check may be conducted prior to volunteering.
