Eligibility & Standards:

All artists who create quality art and crafts of original concept and execution are welcome. The use of commercial kits, purchased items, or direct sales items is prohibited.

Jurying Policy:

All applicants must enclose (or e-mail) four current pictures, three depicting your work and one of your booth set-up, which will be evaluated for craftsmanship, originality, and design. Photographs will be used to verify design and quality if you are accepted into the show, so it is important that they accurately represent your work.
Photos will not be returned.

Application procedure:

Complete the Harvest of Art & Craft Application as well as a Wisconsin Sellers permit. The Milwaukee County Historical Society must forward tax information to the State for all exhibitors. Note: Birthdate is required per Village of Greendale Statute.

1. Enclose

- For registration postmarked by March 4th, early registration fees are: **\$160 Indoor Booth, \$85 Indoor Half Booth, \$140 Outdoor Booth.**
- For registration after March 4th, regular fees are: **\$180 Indoor Booth, \$100 Indoor Half Booth, \$160 Outdoor Booth.**
- Completed WI Sellers permit.
- Three (3) photos of your work and one (1) of your booth set-up. E-mailed photos are preferred.
- Additional parking fee.

The Milwaukee County Historical Society will not assume any liability in the case of loss or damage to work or property from any cause. Insurance responsibility is left to the artist. Artists will abide by the Village of Greendale ordinances and Wisconsin state law including compliance with Fire Department and Village building regulations and will indemnify and hold harmless the Milwaukee County Historical Society, its directors, its officers, the Village of Greendale, and the Milwaukee County Parks Department for any claim or cause of action against those mentioned from acts of exhibitors or anyone else.

Additional Information:

1. The Harvest of Art & Crafts is MCHS's largest fundraiser of the year and we work very hard to make it a success for all.
2. Each full booth space is approximately 10' by 10'. A half booth is approximately 5' by 10'. **Please go to:**
www.milwaukeehistory.net/harvest
for specific information and booth photos.
3. All checks are held until March 31, 2016.
Once accepted, fee is non-refundable.
4. Notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent via e-mail in April.
5. Exhibitors will receive space allocations and additional directions in early August.
6. **We try to accommodate space requests but cannot guarantee them.** Returning exhibitors registered by March 4th will have first preference.
7. Raffle: We ask each artist to donate an item (tax-deductible) for our raffle. A receipt will be mailed to you after the show. This year, the exhibitor whose item has the most tickets at the time of the raffle drawing (Sunday afternoon) will receive a FREE registration fee to Harvest 2017 (\$140 value)!
8. Set-up will be from 12-7pm on Friday the 9th; and 7-9:30am Saturday & Sunday. Camping is not allowed on the grounds.
9. Exhibitors receive all proceeds from sales and are responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax.
