**Abstract:** Frank M. Gabel was born in Chicago in 1877. He got a job as an office boy in 1896 at the Chicago branch of the Blatz Brewing Company. He remained with Blatz until 1903 when he worked with another brewery until 1914. He returned to Blatz and was appointed secretary and treasurer in 1921, vice president in 1931 and was elected president of the brewery in 1942. He married Olga Lindau in 1909. Olga passed away in December 1971 and Frank died in April 1972. Their daughter Dorothy attended the Milwaukee University School, Sacred Heart Academy in Lake Forest, IL, and Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. She married Robert H. Libke in 1947
