In oversize there is 2 proclamations from Heil calling for all males to register for induction, 1942. Heil was born in Germany and came to the United States in 1881. After traveling through the U.S.A he returned to Milwaukee in 1901 and founded the Heil Rail Joint Welding Co. which became The Heil Company. He served two terms as Governor of Wisconsin from 1939-1943.
