**Scope and Content:** Flyer (German) dated Dec. 7, 1886, and a Lenten Pastoral written by Heiss, Archbishop of Milwaukee, Jan. 25, 1885. Michael Heiss was born in Bavaria in 1818 and came to Milwaukee as Archbishop Martin Henni's secretary in 1844. A few notable things he accomplished during his administration were: stabilized the finances of the archdiocese, introduced the parish tax, regularized the legal status of parishes, and formed the first archdiocesan school board. He died in 1890 after 9 years of service.
