Abstract: The International Association of Street and Sanitation Officials was formed in 1920 to represent non-engineers engaged in public works management and service delivery. In 1925, the name was changed to the International Association of Public Works Officials, and two years later, the organization merged with the American Society of Municipal Engineers to form the American Public Works Association.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of the proceedings (2 copies) of the Association's 14th annual convention held at the Hotel Schroeder in Milwaukee. The proceedings include an address by Mayor Dan Hoan and other Milwaukee public works personnel.
