Abstract: The Jewish Vocational Service of Milwaukee, now the Milwaukee Center for Independence, was founded in 1938 to help refugees establish themselves successfully in Milwaukee. In the ensuing years, the organization has offered services to assist disabled and disadvantaged youths and adults.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of newspaper clippings, an accountant's report, a 25th Anniversary booklet about the organization, an audit with related notes and memos, and correspondence between Dr. Norman Gerber, Executive Director of the Vocational Service, and Nate Harris, Chairman of the Intergovernmental Audit Team, which conducted the 1981 audit.
