

Title: Johnston Emergency Hospital Collection

Abstract: The Johnston Emergency Hospital was organized in May 1888 by the Bartlett Clinical Club. The hospital initially was located in the former central police station on Broadway Avenue before moving to land at 320 W. Michigan Street which John Johnston donated in 1894. It remained at that site until 1931 when the hospital was relocated to 1230 W. Grant Street. In 1975, Johnston Hospital was renamed the Johnston Community Health Center, which closed in 2006.
