**Abstract:** Charles D. Weeks was a former general manager of the Milwaukee Coke & Gas Company. His wife, Alice Tenny Weeks, served as a president of the Woman’s Club of Wisconsin. Their son, Francis Dickin Weeks, was born in Milwaukee in 1907. He graduated from Milwaukee Country Day School in 1925, Dartmouth College in 1929 and MIT in 1931. He married Elsie Crane Watkins in 1933 and moved to Highland Park, IL. He worked with Commonwealth Edison from 1932-1942, General Cable Corporation from 1946-1950; and Joslyn Manufacturing from 1950 to 1970. During World War II, he served as a lieutenant and lieutenant commander in the United States Naval Reserve. Both Francis and Elsie were avid world travelers and photographers.

The Watkins family also included astute businessmen and inventive individuals. E.T. Watkins was a director of the Merchants’ Loan and Trust Company in Chicago, and Frederick A. Watkins was an inventor with Colytt Laboratories, patenting telephone mouthpieces.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of genealogical material related to the Wells, Weeks, Watkins, Langdon, Tenny, Smith and Bryant (from Plymouth, MA) families, as well as family photos, scrapbooks, and other ephemera.
