Abstract: Edward Keogh was born in Ireland in 1835 and came to the U.S. with his family in 1841. They eventually settled in Milwaukee, and Edward began a printer's apprenticeship with the *Milwaukee Sentinel* in 1859. He opened his own print shop in 1867. He also was very involved in political affairs, serving in the state assembly and senate for years as a Democrat. He passed away in 1898.
