**Abstract:** The Milwaukee Admirals hockey team was formed in 1970 and played its first season at Wilson Park. The following year, the Admirals began playing games at the downtown Arena. In 1973, the team joined the United States Hockey League and won the league title during the 1975-1976 season. In December 1976, Milwaukee philanthropists Lloyd and Jane Pettit purchased the club. The following year, the Admirals switched to the International Hockey League and became an affiliate of the Buffalo Sabres and Philadelphia Flyers of the National Hockey League (NHL). The team joined the American Hockey League in 2001 (as an affiliate of the NHL) and won the AHL Calder Cup in 2004.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists primarily of scrapbooks with newspaper clippings, photos, programs and other ephemera documenting the Admirals and also the career of former player, coach and general manager Phil Whitliff.
