**Abstract:** The Mayhew Brothers started their lumber business in Milwaukee in 1862. The company had yards at West Water (now Plankinton Ave.) and Wells, on Reed Street (now South 2<sup>nd</sup> St.) and on the Kneeland Canal. The company discontinued in 1882.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of postcards to Mayhew Brothers Lumber Dealers requesting prices, inquiring about delivery of items, and placing orders for goods.
