**Abstract:** Charles Mulcahy graduated from Whitefish Bay High School, Marquette University (where he was a standout tennis player) and Marquette Law School. He was elected to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors in 1964 to represent the 25<sup>th</sup> District (north shore area). After 12 years on the County Board, Mulcahy did not see re-election to devote more time to his law practice. Throughout his distinguished law career, Mulcahy has been involved with numerous civic organizations, such as the Milwaukee County Historical Society, War Memorial Center, Performing Arts Center, Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, and Greater Milwaukee Committee.
