Abstract: Sherman Park Lutheran Church was the result of a merger of Hope Lutheran and Mount Lebanon Lutheran churches in 1923. A new church, located at 2703 N. Sherman Boulevard, was dedicated in April 1924, but, due to the rapidly expanding population on Milwaukee's northwest side, it soon became too small to accommodate the congregation. Consequently, the existing structure was rebuilt, and the new facility was dedicated in May 1929. The church continues to reach out and serve the needs of the Sherman Park neighborhood.
