Abstract: Ivan Dimiter Mishoff was born in Bulgaria in 1858. He emigrated to the U.S. in 1878 and graduated from Princeton University and Rush Medical School. He served as a Presbyterian missionary in Bulgaria from 1889-1891 before returning to Milwaukee and setting up a successful medical practice. He passed away in June 1941.

Scope and Content: The Sm Mss portion of the collection includes research notes re Mishoff; a Volunteer Medical Service Corps certificate, 1918; a Knights Templar insurance policy folder. Mishoff’s diagnosis book, 1890, is located in the Lapham Case (LC), and the oversize items include Mishoff’s membership certificate in Kilbourn Lodge, 1926; Theological diploma, 1887; medical degree from Gale College, 1899; science degree and diploma, 1938; Rush Medical College diploma, 1889; Wisconsin Medical Examiners diploma, 1903; and Bachelor of Arts diploma, 1884.
