**Abstract:** Egbert Mosley came to Milwaukee in 1842 from Detroit and helped establish one of Milwaukee's first foundries/machine shops. He also served as a Milwaukee County sheriff.

**Scope and Content:** The records consist of two pieces of correspondence with one addressed to Mosley, Milwaukee Sheriff, 1849; certificate re clerkship of James B. Cross, 1841; handwritten description of countryside in the west, n.d.; envelope addressed to Mosley; newspaper clipping re Wisconsin laws, 1868; and business card of Graham, Davis & Gardiner attorneys.
