

**Title:** Associated Charities of Milwaukee Collection

**Abstract:** The Associated Charities of Milwaukee was organized in January 1882 to coordinate activities among the city's various charities and "employ practical methods for the prevention of pauperism, the promotion of thrift and the more effective relief of the worthy poor." The organization was incorporated in 1886. In December 1921, the name was changed to the Family Welfare Association.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of the organization's articles of incorporation, minutes of annual meetings, constitution and by-laws, solicitation letters, a brief history of the endowment fund, and 1889 poor list.
