**Abstract:** Alvin Brazee was born in Wauwatosa in July 1855. He attended Wauwatosa public schools before enrolling at Ripon College. He left school before earning his degree and took on a variety of jobs before deciding to study law in 1876. Brazee practiced in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, and in Nebraska until he relocated to Milwaukee in 1880. He was a partner in several law firms, earning a reputation as a successful attorney in criminal cases. He was elected district attorney of Milwaukee County in 1894, and then Governor Scofield appointed him to the Municipal Court bench in 1900. He was reelected to the post several times. He passed away in 1910.
