**Abstract:** Walter M. King was born in Whitewater, Wisconsin. He entered the Union Army on April 23, 1861, as a private in "A" Company, 4<sup>th</sup> Wisconsin Cavalry. He was wounded in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, in February 1864 and was mustered out in July of that year when his term expired.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of diaries, correspondence and other material related to King's Civil War service as well as material related to the King family in general.

**Access and Use:** No restrictions

**Language:** English
