Abstract: The Milwaukee Art Museum roots reach back to 1888, when it opened as the city's first art gallery. In 1957, the Milwaukee Art Center (now the Art Museum) was formed when the Milwaukee Art Institute and Layton Art Gallery merged their collections and moved into the new War Memorial Center, designed by Finnish-American architect Eero Saarinen. The museum expanded with construction of the Kahler Building in 1975 and the Quadracci Pavilion in 2001, designed by Spanish architect Santiago Calatrava. Today, the museum's 30,000 works of art inspire and educate residents across the country.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of exhibition catalogues/programs, advertising material, annual reports and other ephemera.
