**Abstract:** *The Milwaukee Sentinel* was first published – with startup funds provided by Solomon Juneau – in June 1837. It developed into one of the city’s most influential daily newspapers. The Hearst Corporation bought the paper in 1924 but sold it to the Journal Company in 1962 after a costly strike. In 1995, the *Sentinel* and the *Milwaukee Journal* were consolidated into *The Milwaukee Journal-Sentinel*.

**Scope and Content:** The collection includes historical information, clippings, reprints, atlases, almanacs, and the 1920 annual trade review supplement.
